## **Pig Racing**

## Friday, October 3<sup>rd</sup> 7pm Sitwell Park Golf Club

Four organisations, Rotary, Round Table, 41 Club and Tangent are getting together to organise a social evening, Pig Racing, to raise money for a project at Rotherham Opportunities College. This will buy equipment and train teachers to enable adults of between 16 and 21 with learning difficulties to produce their own podcasts, blogs and radio shows, giving them life-long skills to help them in the future.

The evening starts at 7pm and there will be seven races. Each race will be sponsored for £30 and each of six pigs will be sponsored for £5. The sponsors will get their names in the

programme, and the race sponsor will receive a bottle of Prosecco, and the winning pig owner will get a bottle of wine. The price of entry will be £15. and the event is open to partners and guests and members of the public.

After the fourth race a meal of loaded fries (loaded with pulled pork, chilli or a veggie topping) will be served.

Betting will be on a tote basis with 50% going to people betting on the winning pig and 50% to ROC. There will also be a raffle.

Our club has been asked to provide one or two race sponsors, nine pig sponsors and a decent raffle prize. We would also need to sell about 30 tickets at £15 each.
